Code of Conduct

Last updated on July 20, 2025

Premise

All participants, including the secretariats, advisors, chairs, delegates, guests, staff, and others, must agree and follow this code of conduct. Any behavior that does not comply with any of the disciplines will not be tolerated and may result in a series of regulations specified in this Code of Conduct.

1. Dress Code

- 1. All participants must wear Business Formal/Professional attire at all times during the conference, with school uniforms also being acceptable;
- 2. If, under the decision of the secretariat, a dress code of any participant seems significantly inappropriate, the participant will be subject to *regulation 2(a)*.
- 3. This rule may be partially altered by the Motion to Suspend the Rules under the discretion of a student officer and a secretariat.

2. Pre-written resolution

- 1. Pre-written resolutions are not in order;
- 2. If any pre-written resolutions (including clauses) are found, the participant will be subject to regulation 1(a).

3. Plagiarism/Usage of Al

- All spoken and written works, such as but not limited to speeches, resolutions, amendments, directives, and position papers, submitted to the conference must be done by the participant without the help of other individuals or Al technology at all times:
- 2. If evidence of plagiarism or usage of AI technology is found, a committee of secretariats and advisors reserves the right to penalize the participant under regulation 1(a) and/or regulation 1(b).

4. Exiting the Committee Room

- When any delegate wishes to leave the committee room during committee session, the delegate should leave his/her name card with the staff and inform them;
- 2. Continued violation of this rule may result in regulation 1(a).

5. Language

- 1. The official language of SJAMUN III is English;
- 2. No language other than the official language is to be spoken during committee sessions:
- 3. Continued violation of this rule may result in regulation 1(a).

6. Usage of Electronic Devices

- 1. The usage of electronic devices is allowed only when the committee is in an unmoderated caucus:
 - Delegates may access technology for purposes such as viewing their script, writing resolutions, or any other appropriate activities pertaining to MUN;
- 2. The usage of electronic devices is allowed at all times in KNAC;
- 3. Staff will constantly monitor the appropriateness of tech usage. When inappropriate technology usage is spotted, the staff are to report immediately to a student officer. No direct action shall be taken by the staff;
- 4. Continued violation of this rule may result in regulation 1(a), or, in severe cases, regulation 1(b).

7. Act of Crime

- Any act of crime, including but not limited to drugs, sexual harassment, and violence, will be reported to the committee of secretariats and advisors and will lead to an official report filed to his/her school, parents, and the law enforcement agency, as well as a penalty under all regulations specified in this code of conduct;
- 2. Possession and/or consumption of unprescribed drugs or alcohol is strictly prohibited. If such action is found by or reported to a secretariat or an advisor, the participant will be subject to *all regulations* specified in this code of conduct.

8. Personal Relationships

- 1. All participants must retain their official position;
- 2. No personal relationships may be portrayed during the entire conference;
- 3. Any participant who violates this rule may be subject to regulation 1(a), regulation 1(b), and regulation 2(c).

Regulations

1. Regulations of Disqualification

- a. The participant is not to be considered for any awards in SJAMUN III; or
- b. The participant does not receive a certificate of participation.

2. Regulations of Interdiction

- a. The participant is denied entrance and participation in SJAMUN III until the participant meets all discipline requirements; or
- b. The participant is immediately removed from SJAMUN III; or
- c. The participant is prohibited from participating in any Model United Nations-related activities organized by St. Johnsbury Academy Jeju.
