Criteria	Point Allocated	Expectations
Introduction / General discussion of the topic	10	a) Introduces their topic clearly without being overly vague or detailed. b) Discuss the significance of the topic in general.
Country Stance / Past actions	30	a) Introduces their nation's stances b) Introduces past actions made by their nation and/or any other organizations (or individuals) i) Discuss the impact of past actions
Possible Solution	30	a) Introduces detailed possible solution(s) that is/are supported by their nation's policy
Overall Impression	20	a) The paper is well-written, flows naturally, and shows good connections between sections b) Paper is written in an academic style
Citation	10	a) Provide citation in MLA 9 (or 8) format on a separate page
Total Points:	100	Considerations: a) Providing evidence (Not limited to statistics, speeches, definitions, research, and expert b) comment) enhances your sub-sections c) Delegates are allowed to paste diagrams but should clearly communicate to the reader the purpose/meaning of the diagram

- c) **Limitation:** Maximum of 4 pages (2-3 pages recommended) INCLUDING any and all diagrams if any, EXCLUDING works cited page.
